Fact Sheet

REF: 523 TOTAL HEATING TOTAL CONTROL TARIFF

This is a total space and water-heating package. All heating including storage heaters, direct acting electric fires, towel rails and water heating (which may include an instant shower) are charged at the low rate unit cost of 4.12p per unit 24 hours per day. All rooms must be heated with approximately 60% of the heating package from storage heaters. Prices are Scottish Hydro Electric and include 5% vat.

HOME HEATING

The charge period for the storage heaters is related to the weather. When the outside temperature falls below zero or the forecast is severe the charge periods will be increased. The storage heaters will be charged for a minimum of 5 hours and a maximum of 12 hours.

As part of the Total Heating with Total Control package your focal point electric fire can run on low rate units along with other panel and fan heaters.

WATER HEATING

Where the water heating control is set on TIMED the domestic hot water will heat automatically overnight and during the day.

If these water heating periods do not provide enough hot water or the hot water has been used up, the BOOST can be used to heat the water. All water heating including use of the BOOST is charged at the low rate unit cost of 4.12p per unit 24 hours per day.

COSTS

Two electricity meters are installed one to record all the Domestic Standard units used. The other to record Total Heating Total Control units

Domestic Standard Units, which include lights and all other plug in appliances, are 7.8p per unit. Total Heating Total Control units, which are all space and water-heating units are 4.12p per unit. The basic charge is 26.72p / day.
